Written and directed by Jeffrey Kelley, the film tells the heartbreaking story of a boxer, past his prime, who finds himself

suffering from brain damage in the form of CTE. A life of prize fighting has left the boxer alone and financially ruined. The local film is based on the short story *The Gatekeeper*.

"It was important to me to tell this story to raise awareness of CTE in a way that does not damage the sport I love," adds playwright and director Jeffrey Kelley. "It was not just the sport or the illness that was needed to reach the audience, but also the characters had to be believable, the protagonist needed to be an underdog the audience could root for, and the emotional resonance needed to be genuine."

The Pugilist will run at the BMO Studio Theatre on September 11 at 7:30pm. Tickets are \$11.50 and must be purchased in advance by calling the SJTC box office line at 506-652-7582 ext. 236.
