



Spring production of *The Wolves* cancelled

COVID restrictions force Atlantic Repertory Company to cancel the next production in its season line-up.

SAINT JOHN – The decision has been made to cancel the Atlantic Repertory Company (ARC) production of *The Wolves* which was originally scheduled to take place in May of 2020 and subsequently re-scheduled to be staged at the Irving Oil Field House in April of 2021.

“We are disappointed to cancel ‘The Wolves’. We have been working with many community stakeholders in coordinating this project and there has been a great deal of excitement about this important project which takes such a deep dive into the world of young women.
