

AUDITIONS for CHILDREN

Auditions will be held on **Sunday, June 26th** and **Monday, June 27th** at the Saint John Theatre Company building on 112 Princess Street. The cast of *Miracle on 34th Street* has roles for 3 girls and 1 boy who either *are* of elementary school age or can *look* as though they are.

NOTE: ADULT AUDITIONS will be held in early September.

Miracle on 34th Street will go on stage at Imperial Theatre from Nov. 23rd -26th. Rehearsals will begin in September and will be held three or four nights per week and on Sunday afternoon. The children will have to attend only the rehearsals for the scene(s) they are in. Once we begin running the whole play --- probably in early November --- they will have to attend all rehearsals. The main role of SUZIE is in 10 of the play's 15 scenes and the other children will be in 2 or 3 scenes. Being in the cast of *Miracle on 34th Street* does mean a commitment of time and effort, but this can be a wonderful opportunity for children to have a memorable learning and fun experience.

TO AUDITION: email the director, Bob Doherty at raddoh@gmail.com and tell him **which audition day** you are available on or if you are available on **both days**. Bob will reply to your email and tell you on which day and at what time your audition is scheduled. Audition slots are available on each half hour starting on Sunday, June 26th, at 12:00 pm with the last audition starting at 5:00 pm and starting on Monday, June 27th, at 7:00 pm with the last audition at 9:00pm.

AUDITIONS FOR GIRLS' ROLES

There are two audition scenes that you should prepare. Try to "become" SUZIE in those scenes rather than just trying to read correctly. Memorize her lines in **Scene 2** so you can say them without looking at the page. Don't worry about forgetting lines. If you do forget a line, just ask Bob what the line is and he will tell you. Relax and just have fun playing SUZIE.

AUDITIONS FOR THE BOY ROLE

Boys do not have to prepare a scene. Bob will be asking the boys to imitate the sounds of words in a language other than English. He will say the words and ask the boys to repeat those sounds. HINT: the language is Ukrainian.
