BMO Studio adds three amazing jazz performances to its winter line-up as part of the BMO Studio Mid-Winter Jazz Fest.

The festival wraps up February 13 with **The Mike Biggar Jazz and Blues Revue**, returning after two sold-out runs. Mike Biggar and the band bring new music, new members, and their crowd-pleasing mix of jazz, blues and R&B.
